How to Keep Your Interest List Information Current

Introduction

You are receiving this because you joined the Home and Community-based Services (HCS) or Texas Home Living (TxHmL) Medicaid Waiver Program interest list.

Sometimes, the local intellectual and developmental disability authority that serves your area needs to call or write to you about your interest list(s). You are required to keep your phone number and address updated so they can contact you.

If you move or get a new phone number, tell your local intellectual and developmental disability authority and ask them to update your interest list records, or make the updates yourself using the [Your Texas Benefits website](#).

What is Your Texas Benefits?

Your Texas Benefits is a website for Texans to apply for help, join an interest list for certain Medicaid waiver programs, or update their phone number and address on program interest lists they joined.

How do I change my phone number and address using the Your Texas Benefits website?

Log in to your account at YourTexasBenefits.com.

If you don't have an account, click on Create an Account.

If this is the first time you are logging in, you'll need to link your Your Texas Benefits account to your interest list.

To link your Your Texas Benefits account to your interest list:

- Under Quick Links, click on Interest List Manager.
- Under My Interest List ID, click on Find my Interest List ID.
- Choose a way to identify yourself (Interest List ID, Social Security number or Medicaid Number).
- Enter your identification number and click on Next.
- Click on Add this Interest List ID.

To change your phone number or address after you've linked your account:

- Under Quick Links, click on Interest List Manager.
- Under My Interest List ID, click on View details.
- Under Interest List ID Information, click on Edit Interest List ID Information.
- On the Personal Information page, click on Next.
- Enter your new phone number and address then click on Next.
- Answer the required questions under Services Information.
- Click on Submit to save your changes.
