

Notice of SSI Medicaid Ending Instructions

Purpose

Provides Supplemental Security Income (SSI) recipients:

- notification that their Medicaid benefits are denied due to the denial of their SSI benefits;
- information on potential eligibility for Medicaid without SSI;
- instructions on how to apply for other types of Medicaid;
- contact information for the Social Security Administration (SSA) if they want to appeal the SSA's decision; and
- contact information for legal advice.

Procedures When to Prepare

When the SSA notifies Texas Health and Human Services (HHS) that an SSI recipient's benefits are denied or suspended, TIERS automatically prints and sends Notice of SSI Medicaid Ending to the SSI recipient. The notice has the last day of Medicaid coverage for the SSI recipient at the top of the notice. It is a TIERS generated notice that is printed with a cover sheet that has the SSI recipient's name, address, case number, and the date the notice was printed.

Note: TIERS does not generate Notice of SSI Medicaid Ending if the SSI recipient is deceased.

Number of Copies

Every SSI recipient denied Medicaid receives one copy.

Transmittal

TIERS sends Notice of SSI Medicaid Ending to the SSI recipient. The notice advises the SSI recipient of their Medicaid denial and of the requirements needed for continued Medicaid coverage.

Mailing Cycle

Notice of SSI Medicaid Ending is mailed daily.

Form Retention

The department does not keep a copy of this form.
